#DigPINS is a participatory open online professional development course.

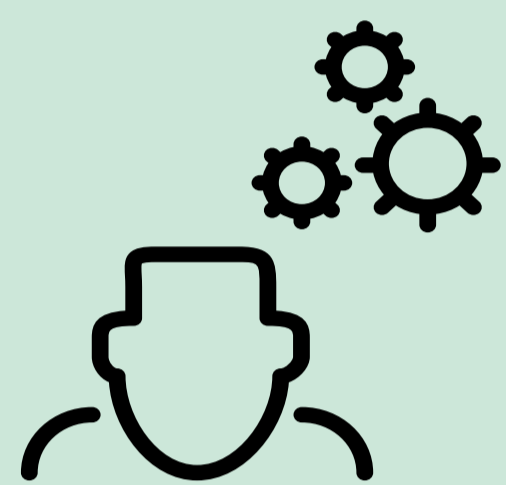
It is being run from Jan. 3-24 with those who teach at St. Norbert College



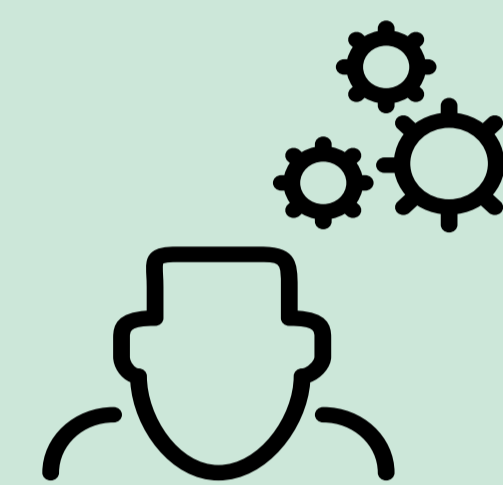
#DigPINS looks at Digital Pedagogy, Identity, Networks, and Scholarship

We will cover 4 kernels over 3 weeks

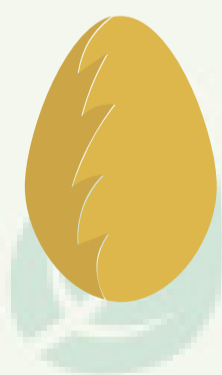

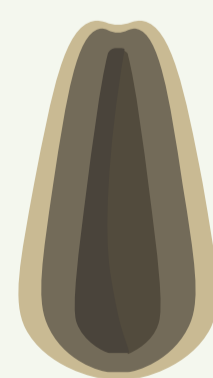

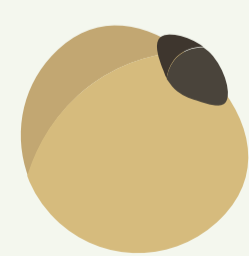
